Submit a separate application for each course in which you wish to enroll (photocopy the two sides of this form as many times as you need to do so, for this purpose). *Please do not send payment with this application*: no payment is due until you have been notified of admission into the course or courses for which you have applied. This application may be returned either by mail or by fax. It will be acknowledged via email upon receipt. First-round admission decisions are made three months prior to the start of the course (see the Current Schedule page on the RBS website for the exact dates), and you will be notified at once both via email and via U.S. mail of your admit status. Thereafter, where there is still room, students will be admitted on a rolling basis as the instructors make their decisions until the course is full, again with both email and U.S. mail notification.

The tuition for each RBS 2007 course is \$870. Reasonably priced hotel accommodations will be available within walking distance of Alderman Library (where most RBS activities take place). Information about housing will be sent out with notification of admission.
